1- Who should I contact for assistance when death is imminent in my family?

- It is the responsibility of the survivors of a deceased person to arrange the funeral. For complete funeral services, please contact Muslim funeral service AS on +47 96 964 740.

2. What is an Islamic funeral?

- The main rituals of preparing the body for an Islamic burial are: wash (Gusl), enshrouding (Kafan), transportation of the body first to a mosque for the funeral prayer (salat ul janzah) and then to a Muslim cemetery in Norway or abroad. Afore-mentioned rituals are performed according to Islamic law.

3. Do I need to fill out any forms?

- We takes care of this and provides full assistance.

4- Who is responsible for transportation of the deceased to and from the hospital, the mosque and the Muslim cemetery / outside Norway?

- We are responsible for arranging all the transportation carried to and from hospital, home, laundry, mosque and cemetery. For transportation outside Norway freight charges will be charged accordingly.

5- Is it allowed to bury in another municipality than Municipality of residence in Norway?

- Yes, it is possible against extra charges as per requirement from a desired municipality.

6- Who arranges the bathing (Ghusal) and enshrouding (Kafan) of the deceased?

- We provide the following: washing room, washing kit (towel, kafoor, zamzam, cotton, Q-tips, gloves, apron, soap, etc.) and kafan.

Muslim funeral service AS also provide the Islamic grave stones at competitive prices. The deceased name, date of birth and death are inscribed on it. One can also order to inscribe a desired text in any language on to it including a verse from Ouran and Kalima.


